Cultural & Learning Hub receives Arts Council England funding

We are delighted to announce that our stage two application to Arts Council England has been successful. Arts Council England has agreed to support the Tunbridge Wells Cultural & Learning Hub project with a capital grant of £886,250 toward the costs of the improvements, refurbishment and alterations to the existing buildings and the provision of a print room, artist resource, a temporary exhibition space and a number of artist commissions throughout the building.

The receipt of funding from the Arts Council is subject to the project successfully securing stage two funding from the Heritage Lottery Fund, the outcome of which should be known in April 2018.



The Cultural & Learning Hub project aims to bring together

the Museum, Art Gallery, Library, Adult Education, Tourist Information and Gateway services in one conserved and modernised building. The project has previously received development stage funding from both the Arts Council & Heritage Lottery Fund.

Planning Permission
