

Session: Art Study Experience

Our Art Study Days are intended for use by Secondary Schools and are designed to explore elements our art collection, which is not normally on display. During a visit, students will be able to engage with Curators and Art Gallery staff, to establish greater confidence and a deeper understanding of art. Staff will encourage students to evaluate works, and communicate their ideas effectively. The structure of the day itself will feature opportunities to create their own works of art inspired by what they have seen, and plenty of time to discuss ideas with curators and each other. Ultimately, each experience can be tailored to the instructors needs.

Duration: 2.5hrs (Museum)
