Consultation:

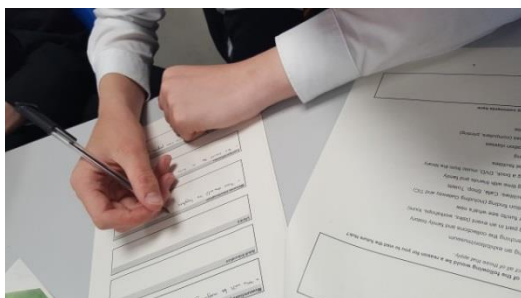
